Post Service Officer Report

The Military Times just put out an article this morning about a retiree's wife's checking to see if you are still covered under Tricare Select. Really not a bad idea.

"I would highly recommend anyone who believes they are enrolled in Tricare Select to verify their enrollment is active, or at least verify the monthly withdrawal is happening as expected," said Constance Hathaway. On Feb. 8, the day before a scheduled medical procedure, she and her husband — an Army retiree — discovered they no longer had health insurance through Tricare West — although they had set up their automatic payment in October.

As of Jan. 1, working-age retirees in Tricare Select are required by law to pay new enrollment fees of \$12.50 per month for individuals or \$25 per month for family coverage. These retirees were required to set up a payment process by allotment, or automatic payments through electronic funds transfers from a bank account, debit card or credit card. This does not affect retirees who are in Tricare for Life, Tricare Prime, or those using a premium-based plan. Nor does it

affect active-duty families on Tricare Select, survivors of deceased active-duty members, or medically retired veterans and family members.

As of this writing I have three projects I am working on. Some you can assist, and some are waiting for long term answers.

- 1.We have a Legion member who needs a wheelchair ramp and small patio. Our SAL Commander, Tom Harris, is getting a material list together and then we will be looking for volunteers to assist in the build. Also, the member has several trees that need to be taken down so we are looking for a professional to volunteer their time on this one.
- 2.By the time you read this hopefully we will have moved a metal carport for another Legion family member. She is getting a new mobile home and it needs to be moved to pull the old one out and put the new one in. After the new mobile home is moved in we will need assistance in putting it back and secured. If you are on Facebook, you can check on Legion 283 on dates and progress.
- 3. There is a military family in Atlantic Beach where the retired husband has ALS. The wife, also a Navy Veteran, applied to the VA for a Specially Adapted Housing Program (SAHP). Unfortunately, the contractor modifying the house was dishonest and now the work is at a halt awaiting a lawsuit. Meanwhile the VA and Eldersource have pulled the support from the Veteran's Directed Care (VDC) program that provides home and community-based services where the caregiver is experiencing a burden. Because Chris, the husband, is bedridden with ALS, he uses his eyes and a laptop to communicate, this has provided a huge burden on the wife. I am working to try to either restore the services or find other means to provide the services.

For things we accomplished last month, we provided two wheelchairs to the Honor Flight program, a small aluminum wheelchair ramp to a veteran in Green Cove Springs, and the Auxiliary stepped in to provide food to a needy Veteran family. The Legion family takes care of others and I am grateful for your support.
